

# Construction Activity Training Sessions for Contractors and Developers dealing with Stormwater, Erosion and Sediment Control

APPROVED 4 HOUR TRAINING SESSIONS

REQUIRED FOR ALL COMPANIES WORKING UNDER NYSDEC'S STORMWATER PERMIT

Under the NYS DEC's Stormwater Permit GP-0-15-002, all developers, contractors and subcontractors must identify at least one *trained individual* from their company that will be responsible for implementation of the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), and have at least one *trained individual* on site on a daily basis when soil disturbance activities are being performed. Also, developers must have a *qualified inspector* conduct regular site inspections in accordance with GP-0-15-002.

All *Qualified Inspectors* (that work under the direct supervision of a P.E.) and *trained individuals* must complete 4 hours of training in the principles and practices of erosion and sediment control through a program endorsed by NYSDEC, SWCD or CPESC, Inc. Upon completion, each participant will receive a NYS DEC registration number valid for 3 years. CPESC, LA and PE's are exempt from these training requirements.

\*\*\* The individuals responsible for installing, constructing, repairing, maintaining or inspecting erosion and sediment control measures or constructing post-construction stormwater management practices at SPDES-permitted construction sites are required to attend this course every three years. \*\*\*

Training Session includes:

- Information on the stormwater construction permit regulations, contractor responsibilities, permit requirements, how to conduct a site inspection, winter site operations, stormwater, erosion and sediment control management practices.
- Certified instructors with practical experience
- NYS DEC approval for 3 years
- Erosion and Sediment Control Field Notebook (\$35) available upon request
